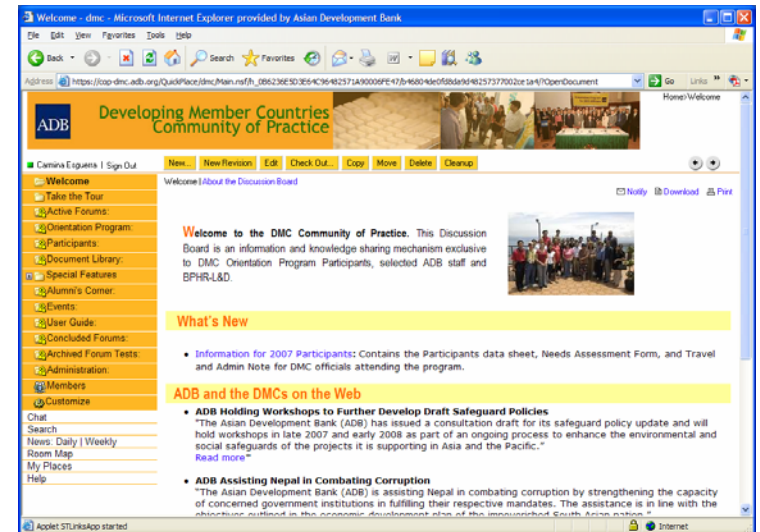

- About the DMC Orientation Programs, events, and ADB's work in the DMCs.

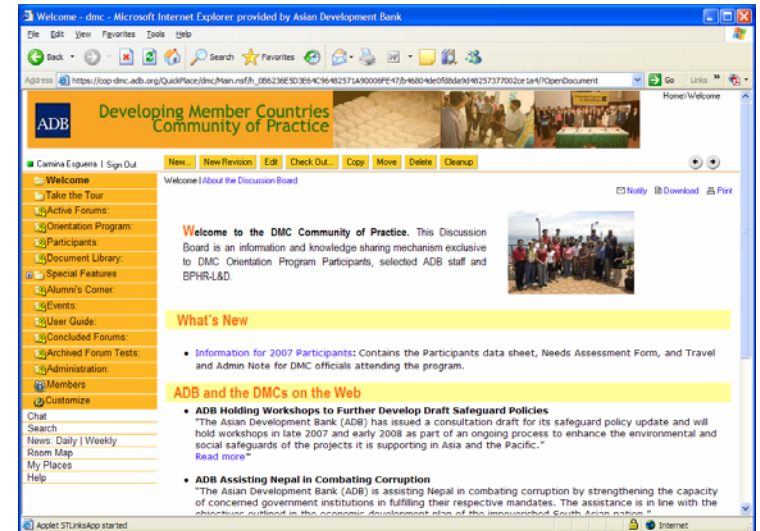


The DMC Discussion Board

- Keep copies of notable presentations from the orientation program, retrieve forms you may have deleted from your computer.

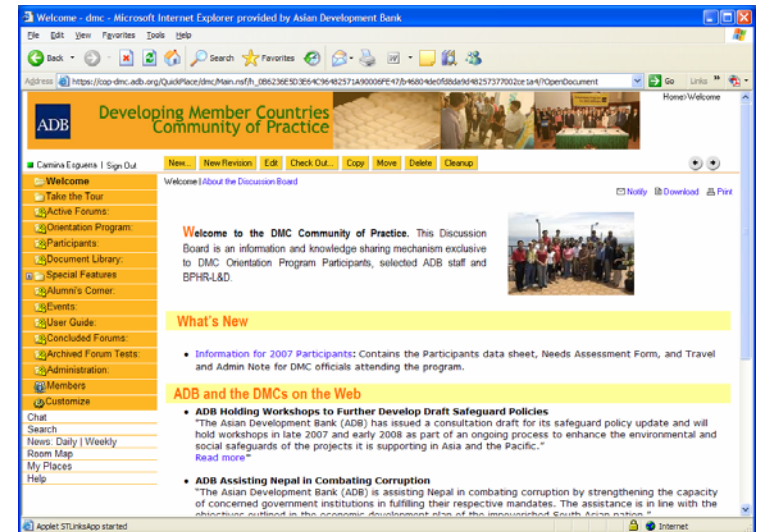

- Post your question online and connect with the people with the answers.

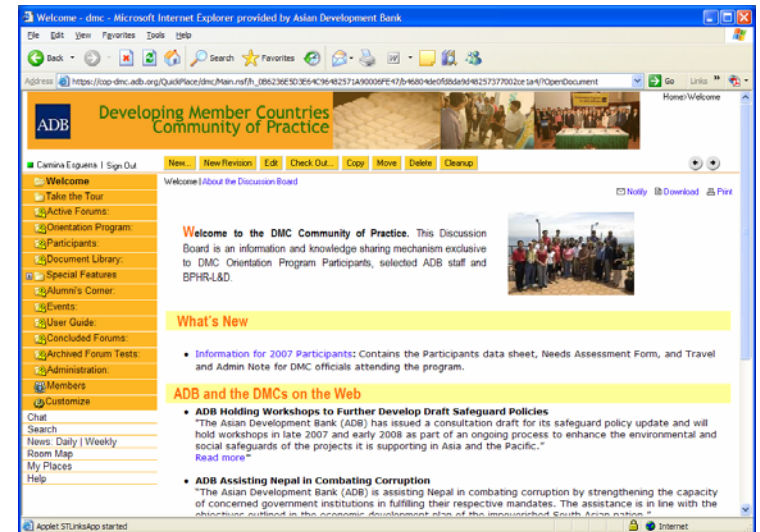


The DMC Discussion Board
