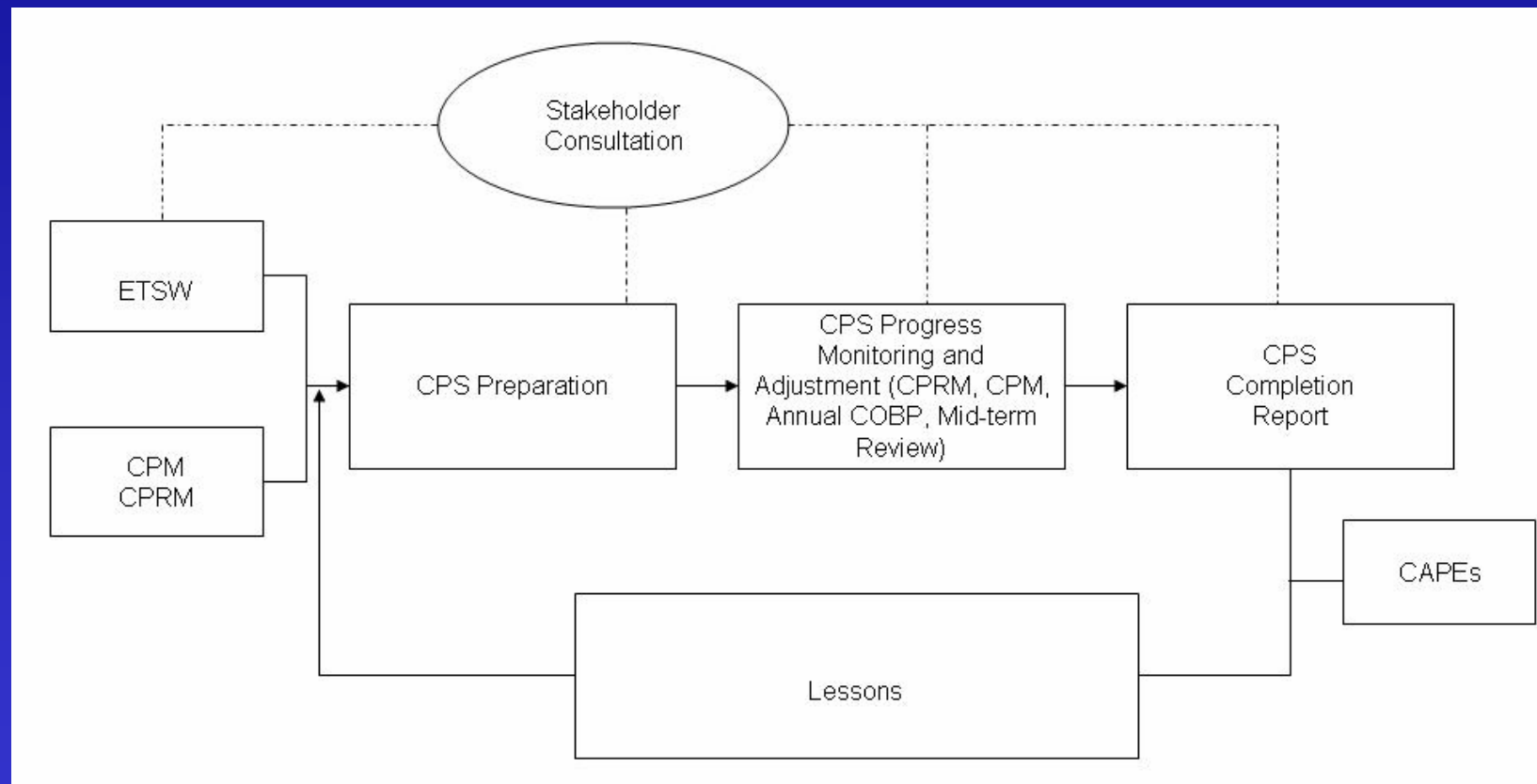

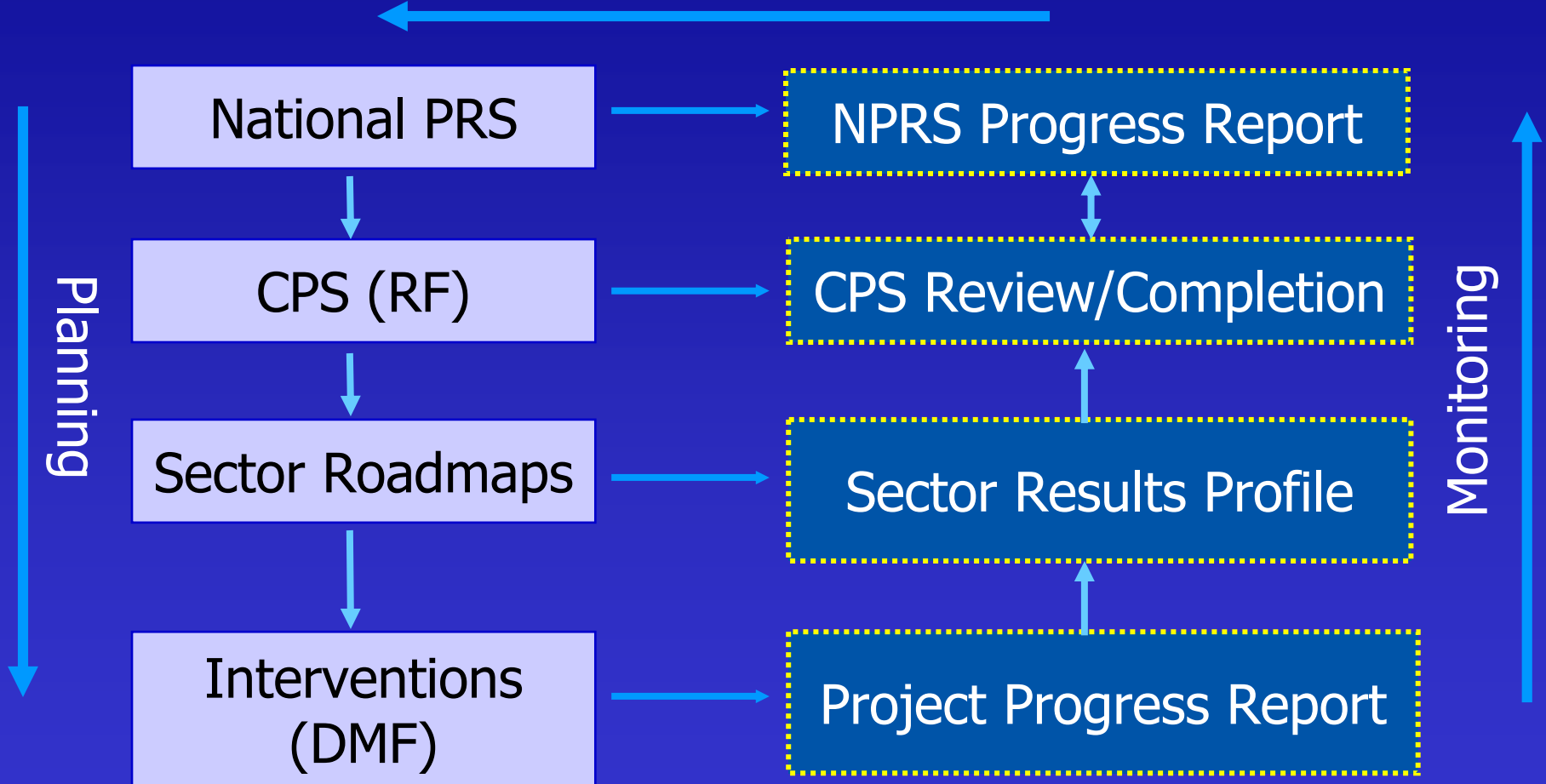

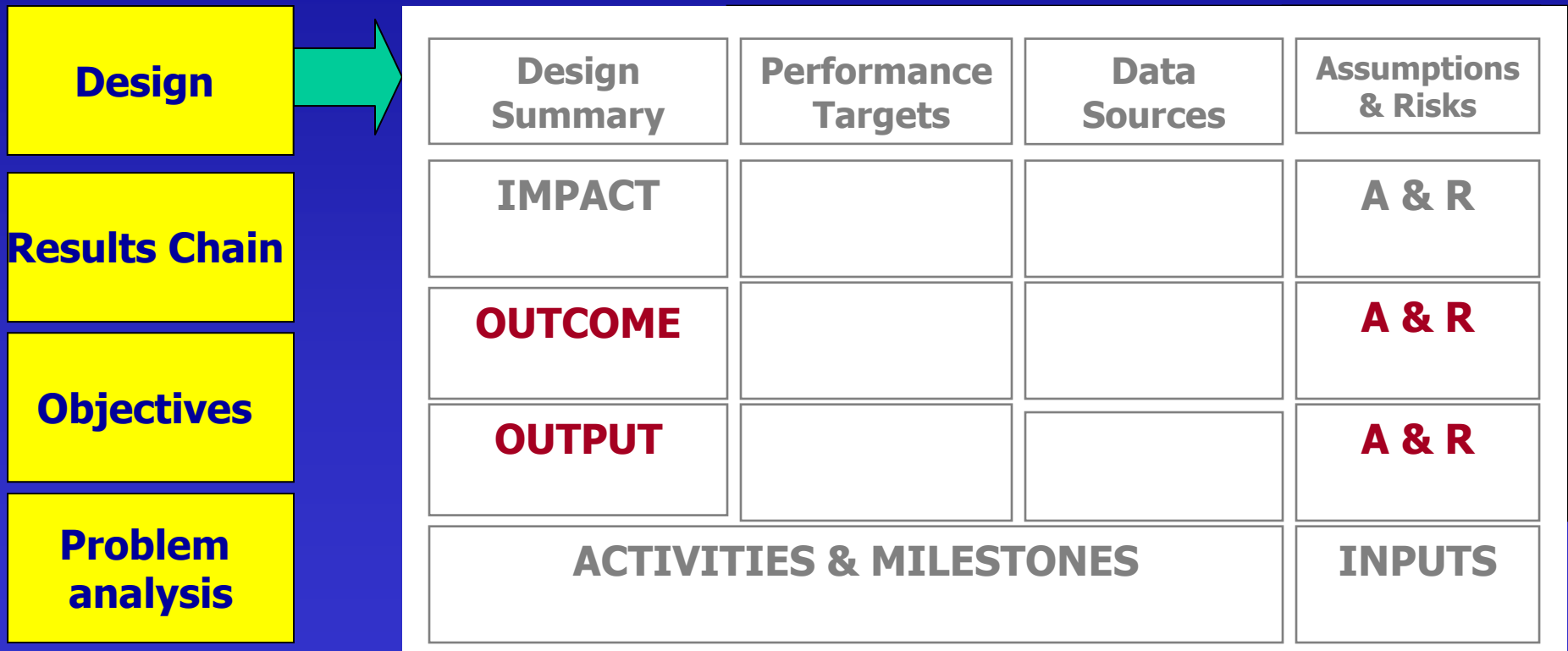

# CPS – Sector & Project Level Monitoring

- **Inputs**
  - Fund Flow – Disbursement (% , amount, etc.)
- **Activities and Milestones**
  - Progress towards program/plan, schedule and budget
- **Outputs**

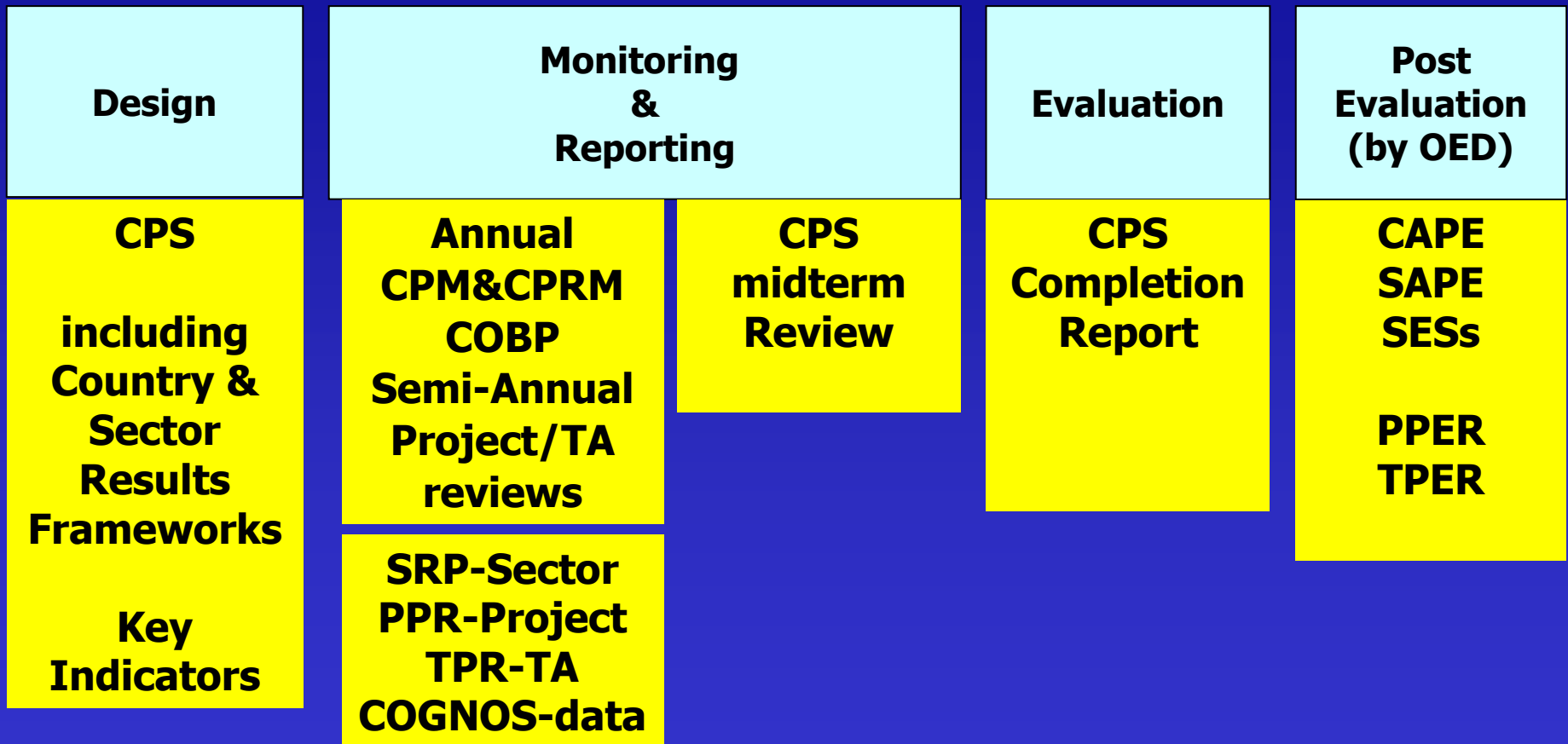
Progress towards:

  - Sector Capacity, Reform and (Policy) Development
  - Physical Outputs (% , km, nos., etc.)
- **Outcomes**

Progress towards

  - Growth and (equitable) access to infrastructure services

# Components of CPS Monitoring Framework:



## **Example of SRP – ROAD SECTOR INDIA**

### **Outcome Targets (work in progress for new CPS)**

#### **National Outcome**

- Support rapid and balanced economic growth through eliminating infrastructure bottlenecks
- Alleviate economic disparities between rural and urban areas through providing rural communities with access to markets and other socio economic opportunities

#### **Sectoral Outcome**

- Establishment of nation-wide transport network
- Improve rural connectivity

## **Example of SRP – ROAD SECTOR INDIA continued**

### **Outcome - Progress Indicators**

#### **Indicators (National):**

- Annual GDP growth rates of India
- Comparative income indicators for various states compared to national average.

#### **Indicators (Sectoral):**

- Length of 4/6 lane roads
- Number of villages connected by all weather roads

## **Example: Bangladesh CPS (approved in October 2005)**

### **Power Sector Outcome Target: Increased Access to Electricity**

**Example of Output Target:** Restructured power sector with commercially operated sector companies and independent regulator by 2008

#### **Progress mid-2007:**

A number of sector entities have been corporatized (5) and are operating commercially.

Two remaining entities, i.e. Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) and Dhaka Electric Supply Authority (DESA) are being corporatized.

An independent sector regulator has been established in April 2004 and started its operations.
