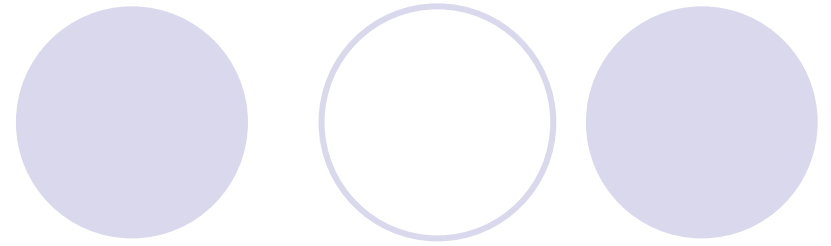
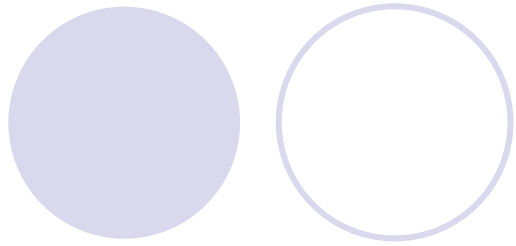

- China joined ADB in 1986
- What's ADB's value-added for China's economic and social development?
- What's China's contribution to ADB?

What's ADB's value-added for China?

- Fund support

- China is now the second largest borrower of ADB. As to the end of 2006, ADB has provided 130 loans to the value of US\$17.9 billion.
- China is now the first largest user of ADB TA grants. As to the end of 2006, ADB has provided 505 TA grants to the value of US\$270 million.

- However, money is not the whole thing.

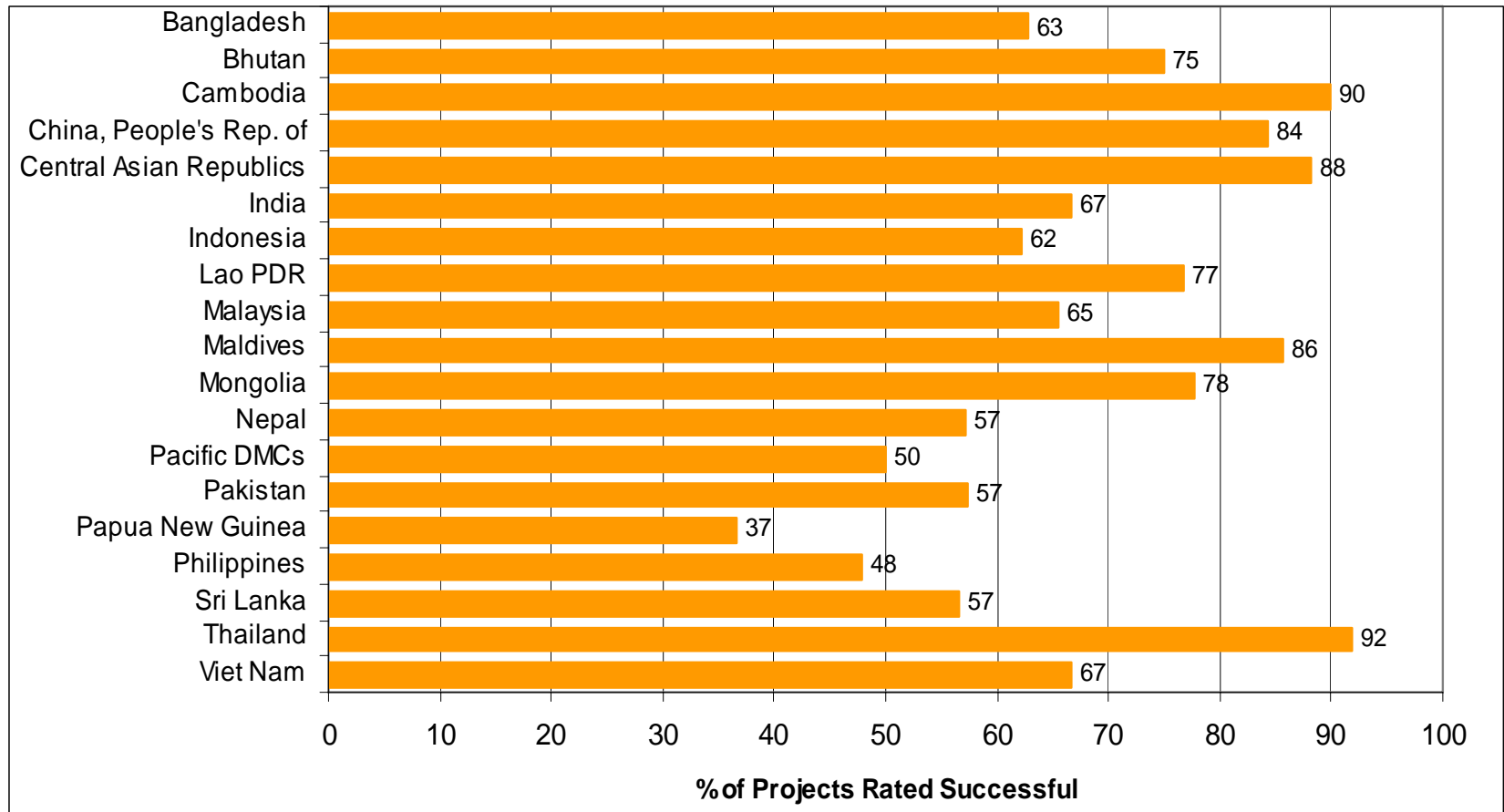
What's ADB's value-added for China?

What's China's contribution to ADB?

- A good donor and a responsible developing country.
 - The 3rd largest shareholder of ADB, with the paid-in capital of US\$ 240 million
 - Contribute US\$ 30 million to ADF9 in 2004
 - Set up in ADB the PRCF with contribution of US\$ 20 million in 2004
 - Share China's development experiences



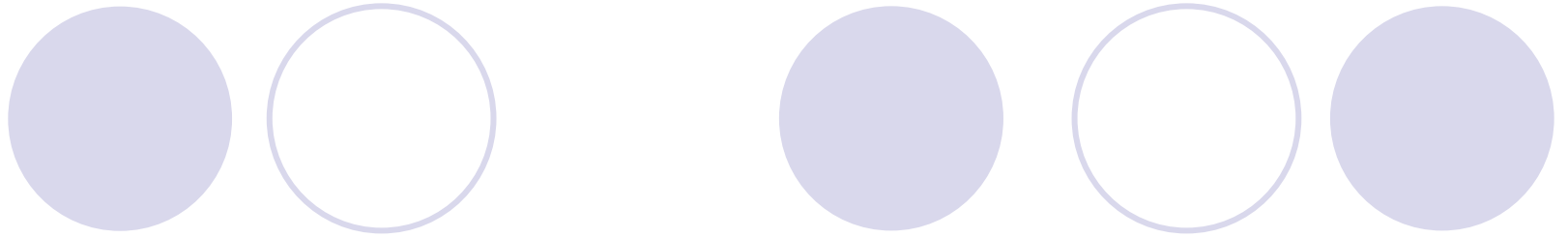
Looking into the future...

Energy and climate change

- China is a major consumer of energy as well as a major emitter of green house gas.
- In light of the negative impact of climate change, environment deterioration, etc., China attached great importance on conservation.
- In the 2006-2010 Plan on Energy Development, China put forward the target of reducing 20% of energy consumption per unit GDP by 2010.
- Various measures have been taken.

How has ADB helped?

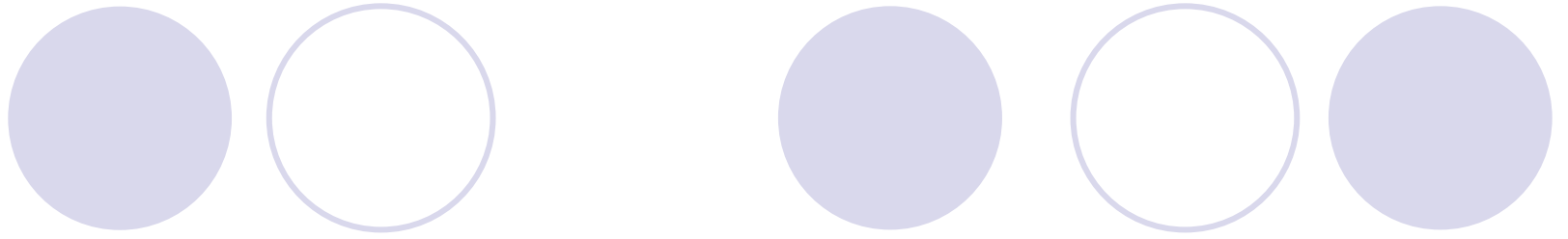


- Support China's energy sector since 1987
- Provide 29 loans to the value of US\$3.5 billion
- Provide about 100 technical assistance grants to the value of US\$50 million
- Extend loans, credit enhancements, technical assistance and other capacity building measures to both the public and private sectors of China

- Simplify loan project procedures
- Coordinate and assist China to access to international technology
- Strengthen cooperation with China's CDMF
